#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

The use of any electrical appliance requires the following common sense safety rules.

Please read these instructions carefully before using the product.

- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazard involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised.
- Keep the iron and cord out of the reach of children aged less than 8 years.
- The iron must not be left unattended while it is connected to the mains supply.

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

- The plug must be removed from the socket before filling the iron with water.
- The iron must be used and rested on a flat stable surface.
- When placing the iron on its heel, ensure that the surface on which the heel is placed is stable.
- The iron is not to be used if it has been dropped, if there are visible signs of damage, or if it is leaking.
- For care and cleaning refer to the relevant section of this manual.
- The filling aperture must not be opened during use.
- CAUTION HOT: Burns can occur from touching hot parts, hot water or steam.
- WARNING: To avoid electric shock, do not immerse appliance in water / liquid.







To reduce limescale damage we recommend using deionised, distilled or demineralised water, available at most large supermarkets. This is particularly important if you live in a hard water area.

Never use battery topping up fluid or water containing any substances like starch, sugar, fragrant additives or defrosted water from a refrigerator. Failure to maintain your iron will invalidate your guarantee.

#### **IMPORTANT**

- Check that the voltage on the rating plate of your appliance corresponds with your house electricity supply which must be A.C. (Alternating Current).
- Do not operate with a damaged supply cord or grommet. It must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not let the mains lead come into contact with the hot soleplate of the iron.
- Should the fuse in the mains plug require changing, replace it with a fuse of the same rating as originally fitted.
- WARNING: This appliance must be earthed.



#### **USING THE IRON**

#### 1. FILLING THE TANK



Before filling the iron with water, ensure the iron is unplugged and the steam control level (2) is set to off.

Remove the water tank from the iron by pressing the water tank release button (5).


Open the water tank bung and fill to the MAX line using the jug supplied.

Replace the bung and re-attach the water tank to the iron.

Do not overfill the iron otherwise it will cause leaking from around the filler cap and may run down the iron.

IN HARD WATER AREAS, WE RECOMMEND USING DEIONISED DISTILLED OR DEMINERALISED WATER. Never use battery topping up fluid or water containing any substances like starch, sugar, fragrant additives or defrosted water from a refrigerator. NOTE: Please see point 2 of 'Exclusions' on page 11.

#### 2. VOLTAGE SELECTION SWITCH



Using the voltage selection switch (6) make sure the product is set to the correct voltage for the local electricity supply.

WARNING: Using the wrong voltage setting may damage your iron and is not covered by the guarantee.




#### 3. TEMPERATURE SELECTION



This iron has only one temperature setting and cannot be adjusted. Before ironing your clothing, we recommend passing the Travel Iron over the inner hem of a garment or similar area to test the temperature is suitable.

Stand the iron on the heel (7) and plug in, when the temperature indicator light (3) stops flashing the iron is ready to use.

#### 4. SELECTING THE STEAM LEVEL




To dry iron, leave the steam control lever (2) in the off position or to steam iron slide the lever to the steam on position.



#### MAINTAINING THE IRON

#### 1. EMPTYING AND STORING



When you have finished ironing, unplug your iron and set the steam control lever (2) to the 'off' position.

Remove the water tank and empty any remaining water.

Ensure the iron is cool and thoroughly dry before wrapping the cord around for storage.

**IMPORTANT:** The cable can be damaged if wound too tightly around the iron and will not be covered by the guarantee.

#### 2. CLEANING THE SOLEPLATE

To clean the non-stick

coated soleplate In the unlikely event of any manmade fibres fusing to the soleplate, pass it over a clean piece of cotton which will draw the deposit off the surface.

Do not use scouring powder or cleaning solution as this could cause damage to the coating.

## **To clean the exterior**Allow the iron to cool and wipe with a damp cloth, then dry.

You may be asked to return a copy of proof of purchase.
